Treatment against tiger mosquitoes using VectoBac[®]G granules

What to treat?

From May to November empty all containers, even small ones, in which water may remain and turn them upside down. Keep watering cans tightly closed when it is not raining. Holes in walls can be treated or filled with sand. Treat with VectoBac®G all stagnant water spots that cannot be eliminated, such as manholes with grates, guttering that is not sealed tightly, sliding grates if they are siphoned off, technical floors, etc.


Natural biotopes and tanks containing certain species of fish or amphibians do not require treatment, as these also feed on mosquito larvae.

What is VectoBac[®]G?

It's a product based on Bti (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis), it is biological and selective for mosquito larvae. It is harmless to humans, animals and the environment. Store the product away from light, in a dry and cool place (<20°C).

Use approx. 30 grains of VectoBac[®]G per manhole

How to apply the product?

Apply approx. 30 grains of VectoBac®G per manhole (approx. 50 I water). If the standing water point is larger or smaller than a manhole cover, adjust the amount of product used. For a gutter manhole, 10 grains are sufficient.

If the grains cannot reach standing water (for example: technical floors), soak the grains in a watering can filled with water for at least 1 hour (quantity of product to be adapted depending on the surface to be treated) and water the floor, trying to pass the solution through the joints so that it reaches the standing water.

Carry out the treatment weekly throughout the summer period (May-September). The grains do NOT degrade in water: if you see them at the bottom of the container/bottle a week after application of the product, this does not mean that the product is still acting, but instead you should repeat the treatment weekly.
